

MAT Preparation (1 page; 7/10/21)

(1) See “MAT - Important Ideas” and “MAT – Extra Material” for notes on topics relevant to the MAT paper (including material that is technically outside the syllabus, but which can be helpful in the exam).

(2) See “MAT Exam Technique” (and also ““MAT Exam Technique – Summary””)

(3) See “MAT – Index of Questions” for recommended multiple choice questions (either because they cover important topics, or because they illustrate useful exam techniques).

(4) Some of the Long Questions cover the same material as the Multiple Choice questions (especially Trigonometry and Geometry), but recurrence relations and counting are a common theme (especially for Question 5), and I would recommend practising these types of questions.

(5) Having completed a question, consider what you might do differently next time, from the point of view of exam technique.

Also, you might like to read over your answers to the Long Questions at a later point, to see how easily they can be followed.
